in case Tommy needed it.

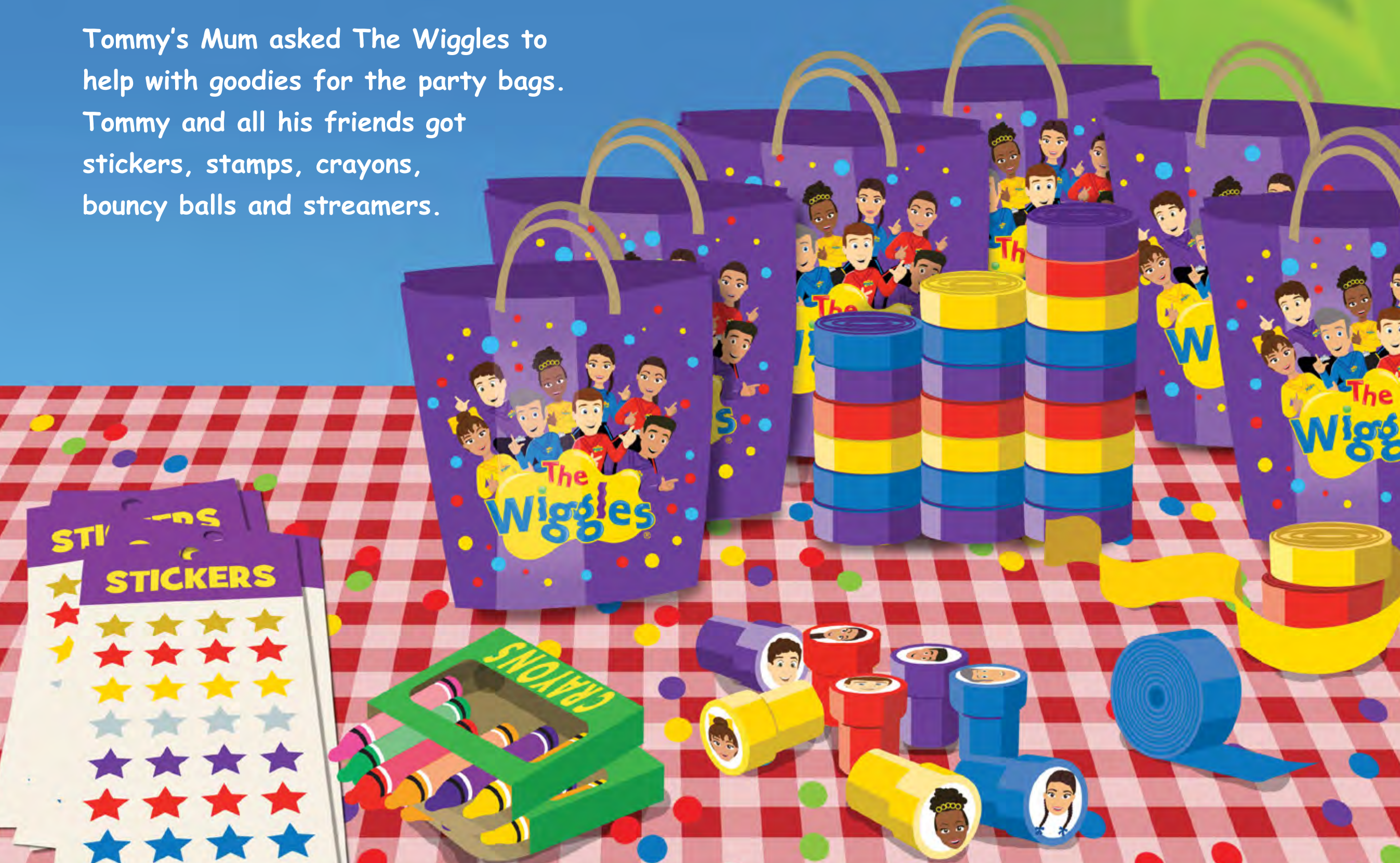


When the friends played

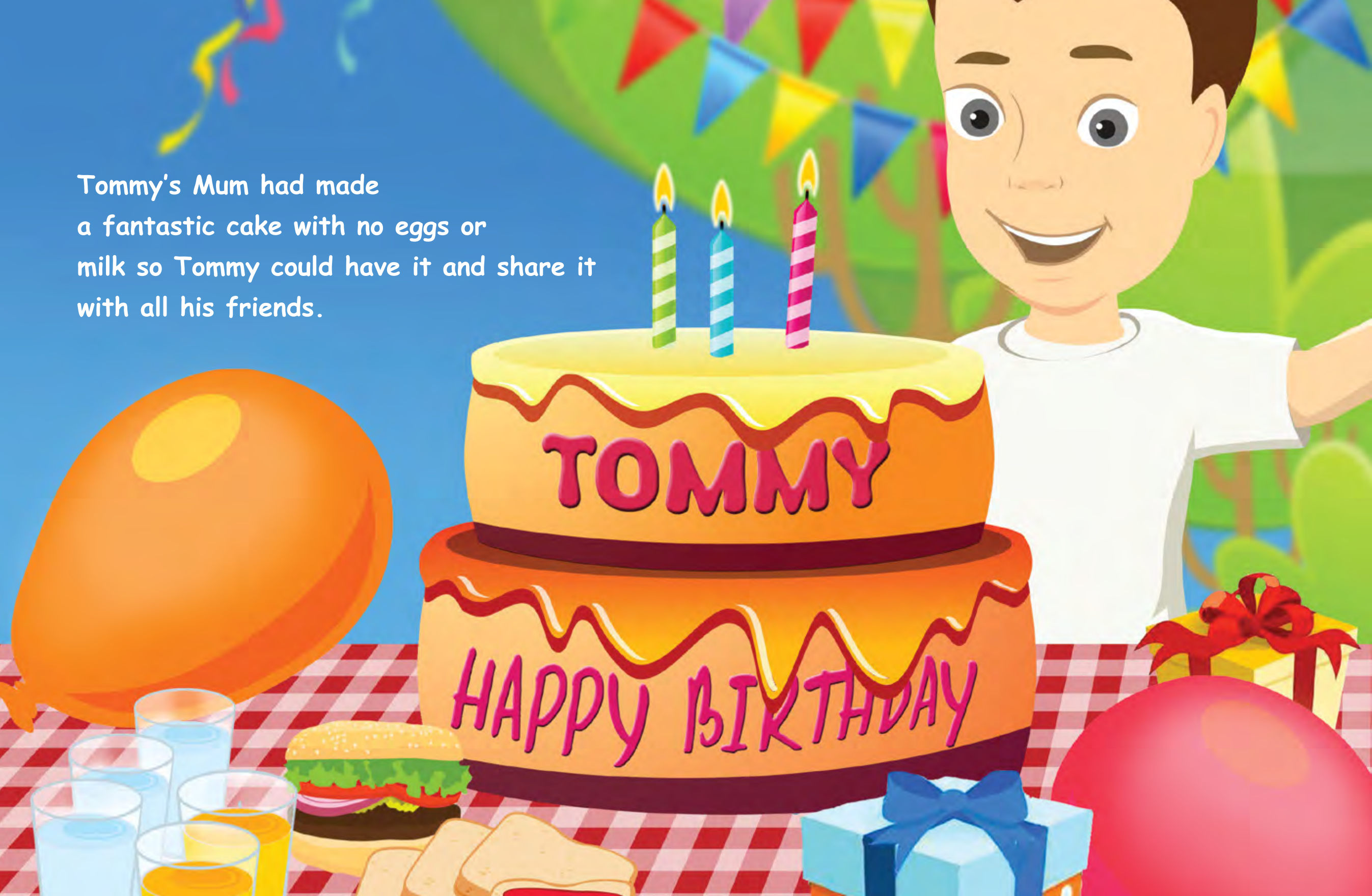


All the children wrapped Tommy in streamers. They laughed when he toppled over and they stumbled and fell too.
